The myth of talent - talent vs skills

The Illusion of Knowing

What matters is what you can "do", not what you "know" Memorisation does not = understanding

Mastery is being able to apply what you have learnt in any context

Process of learning – forest analogy

The Brain

Myelin - the repetition that is required to create it is directly related to the level of skill acquired

Learn from mistakes and correct your course accordingly

Slow down – if someone can recognize what you're playing, it's being practised too fast

Passion and persistence are key

Motor (repetition, stuff you know) vs data skills (short bursts, "thinking" stuff)
